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Planning your Wedding

How to Book

Once you have visited the hotel and decided on a date, we can provisionally hold the requested date for 14 days without any commitment. In order to confirm the booking a Deposit of £500.00 is required.

A further £500.00 shall be required 6 months prior to your Wedding date.

Final payment of the Wedding is required 4 weeks prior to the arrival date. All forms of payment are acceptable .i.e. Cheques, debit or credit cards. Please note, however, that the hotel shall not accept cheques as final payments received within 4 weeks of the Wedding date.

All deposits and pre-payments are non-refundable & non-transferable

All bookings will be contracted and are subject to our terms and conditions

Minimum Numbers

Your Wedding Co-ordinator will discuss minimum chargeable numbers for your event. These must be agreed upon in your contract. Final numbers & details are required 2 weeks prior to the event date. Should the number of guests fall below the minimum contracted numbers, the difference will be charged at the agreed rate.

Please be advised that the hotel may take more than one wedding booking on any given day.

Licensing

The Warehouse Suite has a fully licensed bar which may remain open and serve until 12am



Traditional Wedding Etiquette

Wedding Receptions can be formal or informal. We have put together some information to help with the Traditional Wedding Etiquette.

The Receiving Line:

Greet your guests with a traditional receiving line prior to entering the suite: Bride's Mother, Bride's Father, Bride, Groom, Groom's Mother, Groom's Father, Bridesmaids, Best Man

Once all guests are seated in the room, the top table guests will follow after, everyone will be asked to be upstanding in the room to welcome the Bride & Groom. Grace may be said before the meal commences.

The Top Table:

Best Man, Groom's Mother, Bride's Father, Bride, Groom, Bride's Mother, Groom's Father, Chief Bridesmaid

Cutting of the Cake:

This is announced by either the wedding host or toast master after the main course has been cleared and before dessert is served. The Bride holds the knife in her right hand and the Groom places his hand over hers as they cut the first slice together, guests may take photographs at this time. The cake is then cut and served with coffee.

The top tier of cake is traditionally kept for the christening of the first child.



Traditional Wedding Etiquette ctd.

Toasts & Speeches:

These follow the meal as coffee, cake; Champagne/Sparkling Wine are being served. The speeches are made in the following order:

Brides Father- proposes a toast to the Bride & Groom

Groom- replies on behalf of the Bride & Groom and thanks the parents of the bride and groom for providing the wedding, thanks the guests for their presents and toasts the bridesmaids.

Best Man- replies for the bridesmaids, may read out congratulation cards and toasts the Brides parents.



Countdown to the big day

Some suggestions on how to successfully plan your special memorable day.

12 months prior:

Choose the date
Book the Venue for your celebration
Begin to discuss details with the wedding co-ordinator
Book a honeymoon
Take out wedding insurance if necessary
Choose the Best Man & Chief Bridesmaid

8 months prior:

Start looking for your dress & Outfits for the men Book your mode of transport to the venue Book remaining suppliers like Photographer, Florist & Entertainment Organise toast master or master of ceremonies Choose a retailer for your wedding list

5 months prior:

Organise Wedding Stationary
Choose your Wedding Rings
Order the Wedding Cake, how many tiers?
Book your hair & make up stylist
Is your passport up to date?

2 Months before:

Reconfirm all your bookings
Send invitations at least 6 weeks in advance
Printing of menus and name cards
Choose menus with venue
Choose presents for all attendants

1 Month to go:

Arrange delivery of the cake
Chase outstanding RSVPs so numbers can be finalised
Have a practice hair and make up session
Hold hen and stag nights in the month before

Countdown to the big day ctd.

Some suggestions on how to successfully plan your special memorable day.

2 weeks prior:

Count final numbers and inform venue Check with all supplier that everything is good & pay final balance Meet with your photographer to finalise arrangements Start packing for honeymoon

The Day before:

Get your overnight bags or honeymoon luggage delivered to the hotel Have a manicure Deliver any decorations to the venue Relax have an early night!

The big day:

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast to keep you going until your Wedding Breakfast

Take your time to get ready dep't forget tissues or a handkersh

Take your time to get ready – don't forget tissues or a handkerchief for emotional moments

Terms & Conditions

- **1.** Once you have provisionally booked your Wedding, you will be required to sign a contract and provide a non-refundable deposit of £500.00 within 14 days to secure your booking .NB All deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable
- **2.**Your contract is legally binding and requires you to pay an initial deposit, intermediate payment (6 months prior to the wedding date) and a final payment (1 month before the wedding). If the wedding is cancelled by yourselves at any time all payments already made will be lost. Depending on the timing of the cancellation you may also be required to make the remainder of the payments even if the event itself does not take place.
- **3.** Final payment must be made at least 1 month prior to the date of your Wedding. . Please note that the Hotel shall not accept cheques as final payment method if received within 4 weeks of the wedding date.
- **4**. The maximum capacity seating capacity for banqueting within The Warehouse Suite is 144
- **5**. Definition of "package": booking compromising both Wedding Breakfast and evening reception
- **6**. Room hire is included in our full wedding packages on the understanding that you book both a Wedding Breakfast and evening reception buffet. A room hire fee will apply in all other circumstances.
- **7.** Menu choices along with special dietary requirements must be provided to your wedding co-ordinator no later than 1 month prior to your wedding day.
- **8.** We will contact you approximately two-months prior to your Wedding date to arrange a meeting to discuss the final arrangements and details for your day. If you have any queries or questions prior to this please do not hesitate to contact one of our Wedding Co-ordinators.
- **9.** All prices stated in this brochure are inclusive of VAT at the current rate and all service charges. Prices may vary year on year in line with inflation.

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Terms & Conditions Ctd.

10. Cancellations can be accepted only in writing

Cancellations made will incur loss of all prepayments and deposits paid towards the wedding and in the event that the wedding should be cancelled within 3 months of the date, 100% cancellation charge applies.

- 11. Clients are responsible at all times for the safety and security of any item belonging to them or brought to the hotel by invitees. The hotel will not in any circumstances be liable for any loss or damage to any such item/s.
- **12.The client agrees to arrange payment and attendance of a certified** registrar in the event of a Civil Ceremony held in the hotel.
- **13.Whilst every effort will be made to guarantee prices** Novotel reserves the right to change prices should cost increase beyond our control. All prices can be subject to a 5% seasonal increase
- 14. The hotel holds no responsibility for items left behind 48 hours from the wedding
- **15.** Any damage caused to the premises by invitees will be charged at full rate to signee of this contract
- **16.Under no circumstances can you or any of your** invitees be permitted to bring alcoholic beverages of any kind to be consumed on the hotel premises. If any guests are suspected and found breaching this, they will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
