


THE GRAND BALLROOM






THE **DRAKES**

TWELVE MONTHS TO GO:

| Research and book the wedding transportation | |

NINE MONTHS TO GO:

- Arrange wedding stationary and send out invites
 Listen to a few DJs or bands before booking one to play at the reception
- Decide on a wedding dress ensuring you leave plenty of time for alterations

SIX MONTHS TO GO:

- Arrange formal wear hire for the groom, best man, ushers, page boys and fathers
- Discuss the order of service with registrar, vicar or minister
- Finalise menus with hotel the and attend menu tasting
- Confirm menus and order of service sheets
- Arrange appointments with your florist and cake designer
- Finalise arrangements with your photographer and/or videographer
- Purchase your wedding rings

THREE MONTHS TO GO:

- Finalise the order of service with registrar, vicar or minister, remembering the music
- Make firm arrangements with friends or family offering to help
- Ensure bridesmaids dresses and accessories have been ordered
- Buy shoes, veil, headdress and any other accessories
- Finalise your honeymoon plans and check for any visa or vaccinations that may be necessary
- If the bride plans to change her name have the passport name changed now so they are the same as the travel documents
- Arrange for an appointment with the hotel wedding planner to finalise details

TWO MONTHS TO GO:

- Choose your presents for the best man, ushers, bridesmaids and mothers
- Visit the hairdressers to discuss and have a practise run to see what it looks like (Don't forget to take the bride's wedding headdress if appropriate)
- Visit make-up artist and choose colours

ONE MONTH TO GO:

- Any late invitation replies should be chased up to enable you to finalise the guest list
- Work out seating plan
- Check that all wedding clothes will be ready on time
- Order spending money for the honeymoon
- Check all transportation has been arranged
- Don't forget to ensure the stag and hen nights are arranged
- Pay all suppliers that you have to pay (church, flowers, cake, etc)
- Advise The Chelsea Harbour Hotel of the final guest numbers in writing
- Arrange final details meeting with hotel wedding planner and hotel operations team
