Plas Dolguog has been sensitively converted into a country house hotel comprising of a comfortable bar, lounge, quality cuisine served in Cu Og's Restaurant, and 12 well-appointed ensuite bedrooms.

The unrivalled setting and quality of Plas Dolguog Country House Hotel makes for the ideal location for weddings and functions. The hotel holds a licence for civil wedding ceremonies allowing the complete package to take place within the hotel and spectacular grounds.

Resembling a nature reserve in miniature, Plas Dolguog Estate has received over the last 10 years, the David Bellamy Gold Award for conservation, and in 2002 was credited a special award of excellence, for the work in protecting and enhancing the estate.

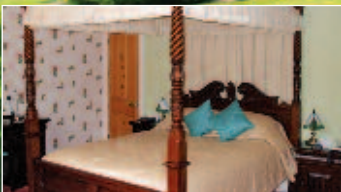
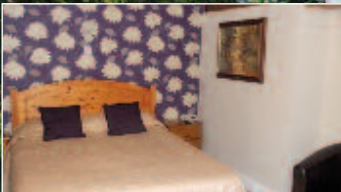
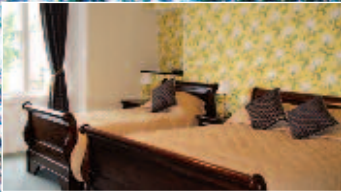
Accommodation...

The hotel bedrooms offer stunning views of the grounds and the breathtaking foothills of Snowdonia National Park. The hotel has 12 ensuite rooms with modern facilities, six rooms in the main hotel and six rooms in the 'Stables annexe'.

In the main house the rooms have an individual character and display many original features of the beautiful 17th century house. The Stables annexe adds a new dimension to the hotels appeal. The ground floor rooms offer the facility for the less mobile guest, and upstairs the Executive and Superior rooms provide a balcony for sitting and viewing the mature gardens and watching the wildlife.

Our bedrooms are individually furnished and decorated, some with balconies or terraces. All have remote control TV, radio, direct-dial telephone, internet access, hair dryer and hospitality tray.

In line with the Smoking ban, all bedrooms and public areas are smoke free. There are bedrooms with balconys and patios which may be requested for an additional charge; there is also a smoking area on the patio by the dining room.





Conference Facilities...

Situated in 9 acres of mature grounds, Plas Dolguog Hotel offers unique, dramatic, yet tranquil surroundings for meetings, presentations, training workshops, team building, small conferences and special events.

The larger of our meeting rooms, Cu Og's Function Room, will comfortably accommodate up to 150 delegates theatre style, and 45 boardroom style. The Sweet Chestnut room is suitable for a maximum of 20 boardroom style, depending on the audio-visual equipment which you wish to use.

For meetings where you are aiming for a particularly relaxed atmosphere, Dolguog lounge is ideal, seating up to 10 delegates.

There is ample private free off-road parking available as well as a range of business equipment.

Cu Og's Restaurant...

Anthony and his team of chefs specialise in freshly prepared food using local Welsh produce (where available). The menus are constantly up-dated to take advantage of seasonal produce, which, in addition to the impressive choice on the bar snack and a la carte menu, together with our specials board, and supported by a varied wine list, makes for a delightful evening meal choice. Dolguog Lounge...

Dolguog Lounge, a cosy sitting room with open fire in the winter, is the perfect place to enjoy afternoon tea or evening coffee, and provides a warm and relaxed atmosphere that makes Plas Dolguog Hotel the place to unwind. Broadband internet access WiFi is also widely accessible in all the guest bedrooms, lounge and the hotel's other ground floor areas.



A licensed venue...

Plas Dolguog Hotel is licensed as a venue for civil wedding ceremonies; therefore allowing you to take advantage of all that Plas Dolguog has to offer by celebrating your special day in one superb venue.

The large Cu Og's Function Room with a seating capacity of 130 guests in a formal layout, and 100 in a more informal arrangement, will ensure that you miss none of the surrounding beauty, which can provide a stunning backdrop for your photographs. An evening celebration with finger buffet can accommodate 190 guests.

We are more than happy to tailor menus to your specific tastes. A variety of vegetarian dishes can be created for guests who prefer, and children's meals are provided. We take pride in creating individual events for each occasion.

Civil wedding ceremony...

The Ceremony can take place at Plas Dolguog Hotel between the hours of 10 am and 5pm and can be conducted in either the Sweet Chestnut Room, or Cu Og's Function Room opening out onto large lawns and a Dyfi Valley view.

For the ceremony each of the rooms will hold the following number of guests:

Sweet Chestnut Room	40
Dolguog Lounge	30
Conservatory	130

On making your booking with us, you will also need to contact the registrar at Machynlleth Register Office to check whether the date and time you require is available (Tel: 01654 703911). Both the Registrar and the hotel will accept bookings up to 12 months in advance.

Points to consider...

- A Civil Marriage is a Public Ceremony and it is a legal requirement that any member of the public who wishes to attend the marriage may do so.
- The bride and groom must agree the content of the Ceremony with the Superintendent Registrar in advance. Any music, reading, words or performance forming any part of the Ceremony must be secular.
- Music may be allowed in the Marriage Room (with the Superintendent Registrar's consent). The hotel would be pleased to help arrange live music such as a string quartet or harpist if desired.
