


HOPETOUN HOUSE

On arrival, guests can enjoy champagne, canapés and music by a roaring log fire or, if the weather is fine, in the Colonnades outside whilst your bridal party's photographs are taken in a secluded spot in the grounds or within the State Apartments.

Decorated with your choice of stunning floral displays and table linen, the Adam Ballroom never fails to impress your guests when revealed. After the banquet and speeches, the bar opens in the Tapestry Room and the party starts in the Ballroom with the first dance. For a truly memorable end to your day, surprise your guests with a pipe band Beating Retreat under floodlight or even combine this with a fantastic fireworks display overlooking the Forth Bridges.

If you are planning to invite more than 160 guests to your wedding then the Adam Stables is ideal for a champagne and canapé reception followed by the wedding banquet and dancing in the beautiful Ballroom.
