

The Wallis Family has been in the motor trade for 80 years but their illustrious history and interest in motoring and flying machines can be traced back more than 100 years beginning with brothers Horace and Percy Wallis who designed and built a monoplane the 'Walbro' which was unveiled in 1910. Unfortunatley disaster struck during a test flight when the monoplane crashed and their plans were abadonned for some 70 years until Wing Commonder Ken Wallis, Horace's son built a copy of his father's and uncle's plane and in 1980 the 'Walbro' did indeed fly.

Ken Wallis and cousin Geoffrey Wallis, Nigel Wallis' father, went on to design and build an autogyro which has been popularised in the 1969 James Bond film 'You Only Live Twice'. Ken Wallis piloted the autogyro 'Little Nelly' for all the action scenes within the film which took 80 flights to capture.

Photographic evidence of the Wallis family's exploits can be seen on display in their classic car showroom at the Wallis and Son site in Barton, Cambridge.

The Bentley S1 was Bentley's first true complete redesign of their standard production car after World War II. Bentley lost the pre war looks and instead gained a beautifully profiled full width body that managed to look both timeless and contemporary. The S1 is a very elegant car which still manages to turn heads to this day. It was once said of the S1 'To the connoisseur who must have the best, it is worth every penny'.

The Bentley S1 is finished in its stylish original colour scheme of two tone grey and inside the Bentley, which will seat three to four passengers, the S1 is fitted with full blue leather and walnut trim.

The MK VI was the first post war luxury car from Bentley. These very expensive cars were a genuine success with a waiting list of over three years.

The Bentley featured as a very early true love for James Bond. Although Bond will forever be associated with Aston Martin, in his books he is very much a Bentley man. After his 1933 Bentley was typically destroyed in *Moonraker* he used his gambling winnings to buy a Bentley Mark VI.

As James Bond once said everyone should have a least one folly in their life. The Bentley was clearly his and choosing our beautiful silver Bentley with luxurious cream leather on your Wedding Day will truly be match made in Fleming.











Daimler dates right back to the dawn of the motor car and provided the foundation stone for the British Car Industry.

Traditional Daimler characteristics had long endeared the marque to the nobility and throughout the 1920s and 30s the company's products were preferred by the Royal Family to those of rivals Rolls-Royce. This undoubtedly helped to create the quality image it presents to this date. The Daimler Fifteen, was produced from 1932 to 1936 and became the most successful Daimler to date. It offered the owner/driver a cut above the average being smaller and lighter than previous models.

Our beautiful Daimler's exterior is charcoal over slate grey with charcoal roof and dark ruby wire wheels. The interior is finished in scarlet red leather and will seat tjree passengers. The Daimler truly is a historic and rare Wedding Car and will certainly make your jounery on your special day even more memorable.



The Jaguar MK II was produced in 1959 and soon became one of the most recognisable saloon car shapes ever made. It was once said that they had all the curves in the right places and should be regarded as a design icon in the same league as the original Coca Cola bottle and The Chrysler Building in Manhattan.

It has featured in TV programmes from *The Sweeney* to *Inspector Morse*. Often described as the 'Morse mobile' it is easy to understand why Inspector Morse used a MK II as his daily form of transport. This Classic 3.8-litre version was one of the fastest cars on the road easily capable of 120 miles an hour. Hence, is was used by many infamous villains of the day, especially those in the bank robbing fraternity.

This particular beauty which will seat three to four passengers is finished in indigo blue with grey

The Rolls-Royce Silver Shadow is a luxurious car that was produced in various forms from 1965.

The luxurious Peninsula Hotel of Hong Kong is renowned for its fleet of Rolls-Royces, which initially comprised seven Silver Shadows; a fact immortalised in the Bond film 'The Man With The Golden Gun'. 

The Land Rover project was made official with design work starting in spring 1947. The first prototype Land Rovers being built on Jeep chassis.

By the start of the 1970s, The Rover Company wanted to give a 'facelift' to the Land Rover, so the Series III was introduced in 1971.

The Land Rover is a classic example of true practicality and it is estimated that over 70% of all Land Rovers ever made are still running around somewhere in the world.

This lovely example is finished in bronze green with a canvas roof. It can carry up to five passengers or alternatively accommodate your amazing wedding dress.








Since as early as World War I, the U.S. Army had been looking for a fast, lightweight all-terrain reconnaissance vehicle. In early 1940, however, things became urgent as the Axis powers began to score victories in Europe and Northern Africa and the need to rapidly develop this vehicle became more urgent. The Army put out a call to automobile manufacturers asking for a running prototype for such a vehicle in just 49 days.

The Ford Motor Company and Willys Overland produced a prototype and following this went on to produce them at rate of one jeep per one and a half minutes! Over 700,000 had left the factories by the end of WWII.

Jeep vehicles were recognized by soldiers and civilians alike as the vehicle that could go anywhere and do anything and have transported everyone from Presidents and British Royalty to Privates and Celebrities and even newlyweds....







The E Type Jaguar was unveiled at the 1961 Geneva Motor Show becoming an instant must- have. The E-Type shocked the world and quickly catapulted to iconic status. Its aggressive, dart-like profile, bulging bonnet and tapering tail were like nothing else on the road.

Along with its looks the E Types stiff chassis and supple suspension gave it a smooth ride and great road-holding. This particular model has a 4.2 engine with automatic gearbox.

Its drool-inducing design helped sell more than 70,000 cars from 1961 to 1975. The fact that it went faster than a Ferrari for half the price didn't hurt, either. This competitive advantage, in addition to its stunning appearance explain its success for nearly 15 years.

The E-Type is finished in Silver with Red Leather upholstery it will seat two adults in the front and two little people in the back and comes with an original Jaguar picnic basket!







With its powerful V8 engine and sports car looks this four seater convertible lead Britain into a new era in the 1970s. Achingly desirable to look at, and with a sountrack to die for, the Stag had the world at its feet and became one of the most popular British Sports Car ever made.

Finished in classic white with full black leather this 1975 3.0-litre Automatic Stag is guaranteed to make your Wedding Day a Triumph.









The Jensen Interceptor was a legendary British sports car, hand-built in the UK. Launched in the mid sixties it was the most powerful car Jensen ever produced and at the time it was mentioned in the same breath as Aston Martin and Bentley.

Powering this stunning car is an impressive 6.3-litre Chrysler V8 engine and inside its two wide opening doors there is ample room for four with its black leather seats with red piping comparable to armchairs.

The Mini is the small car icon of the 1960s. Measuring just 3.05 metres the Mini was revolutionary and became the pioneer of an entire class of small and compact cars being voted the 'greatest British car ever made'. Here we have available for hire the run out model before the car ceased production in 2001. This has all the characteristics of the original Mini with some modern technology to make it a really fun drive.


