

Situated in the heart of the Midlands, Hothorpe Hall and The Woodlands are easily accessible from the A14/M1/M6 motorway network and Market Harborough mainline train station.









Hothorpe Hall offers the fantastic mix of a historic building, the comfort of a well-kept and spacious manor house, stunning grounds with countryside views, and delicious food from resident chefs.

With around eight acres of gardens to enjoy and a large house in which to celebrate your wedding, when you add your very own exclusive use of the venue, you really can make our country house your home for your special day.

Weddings are typically offered with exclusive use meaning you won't share the venue or Hothorpe Hall's gardens with anyone else. Exclusive use weddings are for a minimum of 60 or 75* people during the day and can host up to a total of 200 people in the evening.

Smaller, non-exclusive weddings are also welcome, subject to availability. *Numbers according to season and day of week.





- * Hothorpe Hall offers a choice of licensed ceremony rooms. The traditionally-styled Terrace Room in the old manor house and the larger and more modern Marston Room at the centre of the venue are our most popular.
- ◆ An ornate chapel for blessings is attached to the manor house.





* Celebrate your marriage with family and friends at a drinks reception hosted in your choice of room. There are plenty areas in which to celebrate, allowing you to move freely throughout the house, with no waiting while rooms are re-laid.



- ◆ Your wedding breakfast the first meal taken as a married couple is best suited to our spacious Langton Room. Formerly the stables, its stunning exposed beams complement the room's neutral interior design, allowing you to dress the room to suit your colour scheme.
- + The Trafford Lounge, with licensed bar, sells affordable drinks and has a dancefloor so your party can continue through the evening.



- + You may wish to stay another night and treat yourselves to a night in our luxury treehouse at The Woodlands (subject to availability).






