Ceremony Information

- We are an approved premises for the solemnisation of civil ceremonies and partnerships with up to 200 guests.
- If you choose to have a Church or registry office ceremony offsite, your guest arrival to the National Railway Museum will be from 7pm, with your wedding breakfast commencing at 7.30pm.
- Couples wishing to have their civil ceremony or partnership at the National Railway Museum must contact the York Register Office directly to confirm the date, time and fee for the ceremony.

Other things to remember

- Ceremonies at the National Railway Museum can take place from 5pm (guests can arrive from 4:30pm)
- National Railway Museum opening hours
- November – mid February 10am - 5pm
- Mid February – October 10am - 6pm
- You are required to book Public Liability Insurance for your wedding at the National Railway Museum due to the value of the locomotives and carriage collections. We recommend using Hiscox Insurance.
- The hirer shall maintain insurance cover against loss or damage arising out of the hiring of the accommodation for a total indemnity limit or no less than ten million pounds and shall supply a copy of such insurance policy to SCMG Enterprises upon request.
- Due to the Museum being a unique venue we don't allow helium balloons or confetti within the venue, however we do allow rose petals.
- Naked flames are not allowed in the museum.
- Children's prices can be confirmed nearer to the time of the wedding once attendance and child ages have been confirmed, to allow us to provide a bespoke menu and cost that suits the children attending.
