



ABOUT LARMER TREE

Set in the outstanding landscape of Cranborne Chase, the beautifully designed gardens of Larmer Tree were created by General Pitt Rivers in 1880.

Our stunning II-acre gardens are set in the heart of Cranborne Chase, an area of outstanding natural beauty, tucked away from the hustle and bustle of busy modern life, on the Dorset/Wiltshire border. The Larmer Tree Gardens were created by General Pitt Rivers in 1880 as pleasure grounds for "public enlightenment and entertainment" and are an extraordinary example of Victorian extravagance and vision.

The gardens now are listed by English Heritage on their Register of Parks & Gardens of Special Historic Interest in England. They are home to a dozen peacocks and a pair of free flying macaws.



THE CEREMONY

JUBILEE HALL

TOLLARD ROYAL CHURCH

For a traditional church wedding, there is the church of Saint Peter ad Vincula, a five minute drive from the gardens in the village of Tollard Royal.
