CIVIL CEREMONIES

A civil ceremony is conducted by the superintendent registrar or deputy and can take place in any licensed venue.

Getting married is a very special occasion and choosing your venue is very important, as an alternative to a church or registry office our Rossall and Vantini rooms both have the required approval to hold your ceremony for up to 60 & 110 guests respectively.

Once you have decided on your date you must confirm with the superintendent registrar for the Wyre district that the date is available. They will then advise you where you must both attend to give notice of your intention to marry, what documents you must produce and the fees payable to them. By law, notice cannot be given more than one year in advance and a minimum of fifteen clear days must elapse from the day you give notice to when authority can be issued for the wedding to go ahead. For help and advice from the registrar please contact them on 0845 053 0021.

The registrars are generally quite flexible with the format of a civil ceremony and will adapt the order of service where they can, one of the only restrictions is that there must not be anything religious included.



WEDDING ETIQUETTE

These days, most people are less concerned with etiquette of the wedding ceremony and follow a plan that they feel comfortable with. If however you are interested in the etiquette you can see a traditional plan of the top table here,

Best Man, Groom's Father, Bride's Mother, Groom, Bride, Bride's Father, Groom's Mother, Chief Bridesmaid

We will be happy to advise you on the layout of the rest of your tables dependant on which room the celebration is to take place in and how many guests are invited.

Toasts and speeches normally take place at the end of the wedding breakfast and should each take no longer than ten minutes. After the Bride and Groom have cut the cake, The first toast normally proposed by the Bride's father to "The Bride and Groom", followed by a toast to "Bridesmaids" proposed by the Bridegroom. The Best Man responds to the Groom's speech on behalf of the Bridesmaids. He should also read out any telegrams and a selection of cards.

A Provisional booking will be held for 14 days, after this time a non-refundable deposit of £500.00 is required. Once we have received your deposit a contract exists between the North Euston Limited and yourselves.

Four weeks prior to your Wedding, we request that you pay 50% of your balance. Final numbers and settlement of your account are required no later than seven days prior to your Wedding. For Weddings confirmed more than 12 months in advance, we reserve the right to apply a price increase of up to 5% of the price quoted.

It is recommended that insurance is obtained. If you have to cancel your Wedding, you must telephone the hotel as soon as the reason for cancelling occurs. We then request that you confirm this in writing. Cancellation will become effective once we have received written notification.

Our cancellation charges are as follows:

12 months and over - Forfeit of Deposit only

Between 6 and 12 months - 25% of the rate quoted

Between 2 and 6 months - 50% of the rate quoted

Less than 2 months - 100% of the rate quoted

If we are able to re-book the cancelled date, we will refund the charges (excluding deposit) Prices quoted are inclusive of VAT We reserve the right to cancel your Wedding if the hotel or any part is closed due to circumstances outside its control or you, the client, have not settled the balance of payment by the required settlement date. Clients must comply with all licensing, health and safety and other regulations imposed by any governing authority and not bring any hazardous or dangerous items into the hotel. The client will be responsible

for the orderly conduct of their guests. Whilst children are welcome in the hotel, we cannot accept liability in the event of an accident due to playing. We respectfully request that children are observed closely and

kept in the confines of the Wedding area. May we kindly advise that any unwarranted breakages and cleaning will be charged at the discretion of the manager.
