



The Saloon

Licensed for Civil Ceremonies

Beyond the Great Hall is The Saloon with its beautiful chandeliers and unparalleled views across an ornamental lake to open countryside. Decorated in a colour once described as 'the Soul of Blue' with fine 18th century plasterwork and polished oak floorboards, the Saloon has an ethereal charm, ideal for civil wedding ceremonies. It can only be described as a perfectly glorious and romantic setting for your ceremony. The Saloon caters for up to 120 people for a civil ceremony and up to 70 people for dinner.







The Ballroom

Licensed for Civil Ceremonies

After careful and complete renovation, the Ballroom has been returned to the Hall's magnificent entertainment room. It is a scene fit for sumptuous wedding breakfasts and lavish entertainment. Chandeliers, wonderful paintings and peer glass mirrors create a warm, country house mood. The Ballroom caters for up to 140 people for a civil ceremony and up to 100 people for dinner. The evening reception is usually held in the Ballroom.

The Old Servants' Hall

Accessed from the Ballroom is the Old Servants' Hall, which has been fully refurbished and is now a bar area with an intimate and inviting atmosphere that makes a pleasing contrast to the Ballroom's grandeur. 



Catering

Marguees at Kelmarsh

As the light fades, your guests can dance the night away with floodlit views of the Hall as a backdrop.

Accommodation

What a perfect way to keep your guests entertained, giving you time to make the most of the many photographic opportunities in the surrounding 10 acres of romantic gardens....

Freshly Cut Flowers

Your wedding package includes a selection of in-fill arrangements around the Hall and side rooms. Where possible these flowers will be sourced from the fabulous cut flower borders in the Kelmarsh gardens.

Baby Grand Piano

The baby grand piano is tucked away in the corner of the Saloon. This has proved to be a favourite with couples and you may wish to invite musicians along to provide additional ambience.

Our gardeners are busy decorating a real, 12ft Christmas tree from the Kelmarsh estate, as well as decorating arches, mantelpieces and fireplaces with seasonal foliage and garlands. How to book

We can hold a date with no obligation for up to 2 weeks. A deposit of £1,000 is then required, with a further payment due 3 months before your wedding day and the final balance due 6 weeks prior to your wedding day.

If you are having a civil ceremony, you need to liaise directly with the local Registrar who must be available to conduct the ceremony.
