

PLANNING FOR Your BIG DAY

WE ALL KNOW WEDDINGS TAKE A LOT OF PLANNING, PLENTY OF PREPARATION, AND EXCELLENT ORGANISATION. LET US EASE SOME OF THAT BURDEN WITH THIS QUICK GUIDE TO WHAT YOU NEED TO ARRANGE, AND WHEN.

12-18 MONTHS BEFORE TYING THE KNOT

- Make a decision on the type of ceremony you would like-civil or religious- so you can begin booking a venue, Registry Office or church.
- Although you probably have a date in mind, now is the time to confirm your chosen venue is available. And book it.
- This is your day, and you can have it your way. Do you want a formal, semi-formal, or informal celebration?
- Allocate a budget. Yes, there's every chance things might change, but this is still vital.

- Photographers, videographers and luxury cars are all in high demand- particularly for summer weddings. Be sure to confirm these at the earliest possible moment.
- Begin planning your questlist. This takes time, especially if you have more friends and family than your wedding can hold. Remember-people are understanding of this issue, so try not to worry about causing offence.
- Book a florist and wedding dresser- again, these are often in very high demand.
- Take out wedding insurance. You know, just in case.

6 MONTHS UNTIL THE BIG DAY

- Finalise the outfits for the happy couple and wedding party, pending any final alterations.
- Spend some time deciding on a honeymoon destination; hardly a horrible task, nevertheless it's a big decision.
- Head to the venue to confirm all details with staff.
- Book a hairdresser.
- Send out invitations- giving people as much notice as possible is essential. Remind your guests to book accommodation if they are not local, and ideally suggest some options.

1 MONTH TO GO

- Confirm any last-minute and final details with your venue. This is also the time you should pay the account in full.
- There's a good chance you have already started, but it's wise to write any speeches now before things get really busy. And vows too, if you are choosing to do so.
- Set out a table plan. Once it's done, stick to it.

THE FINAL WEEK BEFORE

- Check that anyone helping with arrangements- bridesmaids and the best man - have a list of all services booked and contact details for each.
- Time for the wedding rehearsal, followed by plenty of excitement as the day is almost here.
- Hand the rings to the best man.
- Arrange when the outfits need to be collected.

ONE OR TWO DAYS AHEAD OF THE EVENT

• Take place cards, gifts and decorations to the venue- call in advance to see when they are able to accommodate this.

YOUR WEDDING DAY

• This is it, the time has finally come. Thanks to your excellent preparation all there is left to do is turn up, relax, and have a ball. It's your day, and you're doing it your way.



















BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

The following is a comprehensive guideline to assist you with your forthcoming plans and arrangements.

1. PROVISIONAL

You can reserve your preferred date for up to 14 days. You are under no obligation and this gives you the time to discuss and co-ordinate your ideas.

2. CONFIRMED

Written confirmation is required for all bookings and a non-refundable deposit of £500.00 is also required.

3. FINAL NUMBERS

Please advise your final numbers 2 weeks prior to the event.

4. CATERING

It is the policy of Hallmark Hotels not to under cater in any circumstances.

5. PAYMENT

An interim payment of 50% of the estimated balance to be paid 6 months prior to event, plus 25% to be paid 12 weeks prior to the event. The final balance should be paid 4 weeks prior to the event. Any additional charges incurred on the day of the event or after the invoice has been sent out to you are due for payment at the time unless you have arranged credit facilities with the hotel.

6. CANCELLATIONS

In the event of cancellation, charges will apply. The percentages will be calculated on the estimated booking value based on your numbers last confirmed.

- With 6 months notice or less 50%
- With 12 weeks notice or less 75%

With 4 weeks notice or less 100%

Cancellation must be in writing to the Sales Office Manager and a receipt of this will be issued to confirm the cancellation. All monies paid are non-refundable.

7. CANCELLATION BY HALLMARK HOTELS

We reserve the right to cancel your booking if:

- You become insolvent or in the case of an individual, become subject to bankruptcy petition
- The booking might damage the reputation of the hotel. In these circumstances, any advance payments will be returned, but the Hotel would not have any other liability.

8. INSURANCE

In common with all Hotels, we do not insure any items you bring onto the premises (such as wedding presents, audio visual equipment etc). We therefore suggest that if you plan to leave any items unattended during your stay, you need to check that you have arranged adequate cover against their damage or loss.

9. USE OF HOTEL

You will need our consent if:

- You wish to use amplification, lighting or similar electrical equipment in the hotel.
- You wish to attach items to the walls, floor or ceilings.
- You wish to use outside suppliers to supply any equipment, or other services.

10. GENERAL

- a) We reserve the right to alter prices without notification. Prices are as stated and are not negotiable.
- b) We reserve the right to change the room(s) being


used should numbers drop or any unforeseen circumstances arise.

- c) Should any guest be unable to correct any aspect of poor behaviour or activities unacceptable to the Hotel, we reserve the right to terminate your stay. Should this occur no monies would be refunded to you.
- d) The client must reimburse the costs of repairing any damage to the property, contents or grounds by any guests to the hotel.
- e) No wines, spirits or food brought into the hotel may be consumed.
- f) The Hotel's name/logo may be used in publicity, once a proof of the promotional material has been agreed with the Hotel.
- g) The Hotel must comply with certain licensing and statutory regulations and requires the Client to fulfil their obligations in this respect.
- h) Prices include V.A.T. unless otherwise specified. This shall be at the rate prevailing when confirmation of the booking was received and is subject to alteration should the rate change.
- i) Any equipment that the Hotel needs to hire in for an event includes delivery, insurance and collection fees.
