




Sleeping

By car

M4 from Reading: Leave M4 at junction 6 and take 1st exit onto A355 to Slough. Continue over roundabout to 1st set of traffic lights and turn right on to A4 Bath Road. At second crossroad, turn left on to B416 William Street. At 2nd mini roundabout take 2nd exit to Wexham Park hospital. Stoke Place is 50 yards on the right.

M4 from London: Leave M4 at junction 5 and take 4th exit on to A4 London Road. At roundabout take 5th exit on to A412 Uxbridge Road. Turn left on to Church Lane. At roundabout take 2nd exit; Stoke Place is 500 yards on the left.

M40: Leave M40 at junction 2. Take A355 to Farnham Common. Turn left on to Templewood Lane. At end of the road turn right on to B416 to Stoke Poges. At mini roundabout turn left and Stoke Place is 50 yards on the right.

By train

London Marylebone to Gerrards Cross Rail Station (20 mins); taxi to hotel (10 mins). London Paddington to Slough Rail Station (15 mins); taxi to hotel (10 mins).

By helicopter

Please be advised both Wexham Park Hospital (Air Ambulance) and Heathrow Airport are within close proximity and should be advised of your intention to land in our grounds.
